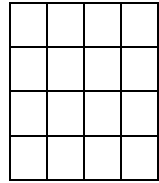


WORKING MAN

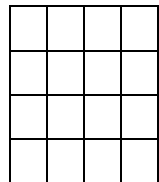
C/ It's a working man I am and I've [F] been down under[C]ground

[G/] Tacit...Looo-oon-[G7/]ng

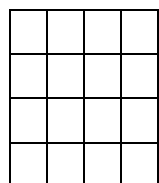
Those [C] long hot summer days, lying there in the sun
